- Hurricane Update Hoskins discussed the national relief efforts to aid the storms victims. All 180 ARC chapters have been mobilized. Clark County has raised \$200K plus for Kitrana victims. When folks turn on their heaters, fires occur, no funding avail to support their displacement needs!!
